Each candidate has to show adequate caliber for a comprehensive and safe ophthalmic practice that includes optics, corrections of refractive errors; retina, vitreous, and uvea; neuro-ophthalmology; pediatric ophthalmology and strabismus; external disease and cornea; glaucoma, cataract and anterior segment; oculoplastic surgery and orbital diseases.

Each candidate has to show competence in practice-based knowledge that involves the investigation and evaluation of care for their patients, the appraisal and assimilation of scientific evidence and improvements in patient care.

Specific points to be evaluated:

- Understanding disease pathophysiology
- Diagnostic skills (History taking, Identification and interpretation of abnormal test findings, Diagnostic procedures)
- Management skills
- Physical examination skills
- Operative and Procedural skills (Preparing patient for surgery, understanding the operative anatomy, ability to do proper operative assessment, evaluation and decision making and appropriate Utilization of resources)
- Decision making
- Interpersonal & Communication Skills
- leadership Promotion, teaching & Learning
- Professionalism & Ethics
- Cognitive skills and problems solving
